E. Resolution to Borrow Fund and Levy Tax for the Loan 2021 International Truck with Snowplow and Wing: Clerk James read the Obligation of Loan from the Board of Commissioner of Public Lands resolution. Stating we are obligating the Town of Gordon for 190,000 at a 2.5% interest for 4 years.
