

CONTROL OF WEEDS AND GRASS

ORDINANCE # 1-85

The Town Board of the Town of Gordon, County of Douglas, State of Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. No person owning property within that area defined as the Townsite of Gordon, shall permit any weeds or grass to grow to a height exceeding eight (8) inches. Any such growth will be declared a nuisance and it shall be the duty of such property owner to mow or cause to be mowed, such grass over eight (8) inches in height. S.S. 66.96 (2)

2. It shall be the duty of the Town Board to enforce this Ordinance and if any person fails to comply, the Town Board shall after five (5) days written notice to the owner, cause the grounds to be mowed or cleaned up and report the cost to the Town Clerk/Treasurer, and to the property owner. Said cost will be collected by the Town within 30 days, or if not paid within that time limit, be assessed against the property owners real estate tax as a special assessment.

Motion to adopt by Brazelton, seconded by Love. Motion carried. Effective upon publication.
