ORDINANCE #02-88

REGULATING PARKING ON ROADWAYS

The Town Board of the Town of Gordon, Douglas County, Wisconsin, does Ordain as follows:

That parking of vehicles along certain roadways creates a possible hazard and inconvenience, therefore to control problem parking, parking will be restricted on certain Townsite roads with signs listing restrictions as follows:

South Frontage Road

A. No parking of any vehicle within the first 15 feet South of County "Y".

B. No truck parking on frontage road at any time unless a delivery truck is loading or unloading merchandise to a vendee.

North Frontage Road

A. No parking of any vehicle within the first 15 feet
North of County "Y".

B. No truck parking on frontage road at any time unless a delivery truck is loading or unloading merchandise to a vendee.

North Gate Road (Old "53")

A. No parking of any vehicle within the first 15 feet
North of County "Y".

Finstad Drive

A. Overnite parking and loading restricted.

School Drive
A. No parking

B. Speed limit of 5 miles per hour.

PENALTY

Any person violating this Ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00) nor more than FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00) for the first offense and not less than FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) nor more than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) for the second or subsequent conviction within a year.

EFFECTIVE DATE

In accordance with the Wisconsin Statute 346.53(6) and 346.55 (2) (3) and 346.56 (lm), this ordinance shall take effect the day after posting has been filed and recorded with the Town Clerk
