**Ordinance #2019-01  
Establishing Rules for Hunting on Town Property**

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Gordon, Douglas County

The Town Board of the Town of Gordon, adopted the following ordinance to regulate hunting on Town of Gordon property as defined by the recreational immunity statute, sec.895.52, in which land owners are generally immune from liability for injuries received by individuals recreating on their lands.

This law provides liability protection to landowners for injury or death of individuals participating in outdoor recreation such as fishing, hunting, trapping, hiking, camping, boating and berry picking activities on their land.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board and voting, provides for the regulation as follows:

A. No more than two (2) portable device (tree stands) per hunter may be left overnight on town lands from September 1- January 31. All portable devices must be removed no later than January 31<sup>st</sup>.

B. Placement of deer blinds/stands on public land does not restrict others from using the blind/stand or hunting the town land where the blind/stand is located.

C. Do not leave a tree stand or ground blind unoccupied unless the owner's name and address has been attached in a manner that is visible and legible to a person on the ground or near the entrance of the ground blind.

D. There will be no damaging trees or cutting shooting lanes or use of screw-in tree stands on town lands.


This ordinance does not apply to town residential developments.


The town clerk shall properly post this ordinance as required under §60.80.
