Boating & Water Safety Ordinance

Purpose: The Purpose of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Applicability and Enforcement: This provision of the ordinance shall apply to all the water located within the boundaries if the Town of Gordon. The enforcement provisions of this Ordinance shall be as stated in Forfeiture and Penalties section.

State Boating and Water Safety Laws Adopted: The statutory provisions describing and defining regulation with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and water related activities and safety in the following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin Statutes, for which the penalty is a forfeiture only, including penalties to be imposed and procedure for prosecuting, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference by the Town of Gordon and made part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.
